DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Key Takeaways

- 1.) Life is short, and we are not promised tomorrow. We must live with an eternal perspective, recognizing that our time here is limited.
- 2.) God has given each of us a purpose and a calling. We should not waste our time chasing insignificance but instead steward our lives well to fulfill God's purpose.
- 3.) Wisdom comes from finding satisfaction in God's faithful love. We must seek fulfillment in Him rather than in the world's temporary pleasures.
- 4.) Our mission is to shine the light of Jesus in a dark and hurting world. We must keep our minds on this mission, even when it becomes challenging or uncomfortable.
- 5.) We cannot pour from an empty vessel. It is crucial to stay close to God and continually refill ourselves spiritually so that we can effectively minister to others.

Discussion Questions

- 1.) What does it mean to you to "number your days carefully" (Psalm 90:12)? How can we develop wisdom in our hearts by doing this?
- 2.) PZ mentioned that our days are limited, but our impact isn't. How can we make the most of the time we have been given to maximize our impact for God's kingdom?
- 3.) Share a time when you felt like you were waiting for the "right time" to fulfill God's calling on your life. What helped you realize that the time is now?
- 4.) How can we keep our minds on the mission to shine the light of Jesus in a dark and hurting world, even when it becomes uncomfortable or challenging?
- 5.) PZ emphasized the importance of staying close to the source (God) to refill ourselves. What practical steps can you take to ensure you are being filled up spiritually so that you can pour into others?

Practical Applications

- 1.) Take time this week to reflect on your life and consider how you can make the most of the time you have been given. Identify areas where you may be wasting time and seek God's guidance on how to better steward your days.
- 2.) Commit to spending regular time in prayer and Bible study to stay close to the source and refill yourself spiritually. Consider setting aside a specific time each day for this purpose.
- 3.) Look for opportunities to shine the light of Jesus in your daily life, whether it's through acts of kindness, sharing your testimony, or inviting someone to church. Be intentional about maximizing your impact for God's kingdom.
- 4.) If you have been hesitating to step into God's calling on your life, take a step of faith this week. Trust that God's timing is perfect and that He will equip you for the task ahead.
- 5.) Share with your small group any areas where you feel spiritually drained or in need of encouragement. Pray for one another and hold each other accountable to staying close to God and fulfilling His purpose for your lives.
