

Day 1: The Holiness of God

Bible Reading: Isaiah 6:1-8

#### **Devotional**

God's holiness is His most emphasized attribute in Scripture. As we read about Isaiah's vision, we're confronted with the overwhelming nature of God's holiness. The seraphim cry "Holy, holy," emphasizing God's set-apartness and perfection.

### **Application**

Today, reflect on God's holiness and how it impacts your view of Him. How does recognizing God's holiness change your approach to worship and daily living? Consider ways you can pursue holiness in your own life, not as a means to earn God's favor, but as a response to His character.

Day 2: Surrendering to God's Will

Bible Reading: Romans 12:1-2

#### Devotional

The first step in pursuing holiness is surrendering our lives to God. Paul urges us to offer our bodies as living sacrifices, which is our spiritual act of worship. This involves deferring our own desires and plans to God's will.

# **Application**

Today, start your day with a prayer of surrender, acknowledging God's lordship over every aspect of your life. Ask Him to transform your mind so that you can discern His good, pleasing, and perfect will. How might your day look different if you truly lived as a "living sacrifice"?



**Day 3: Declaring God's Victory** 

Bible Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:54-58

#### **Devotional**

As believers, we can declare victory even in the midst of struggles because we know the ultimate outcome. Christ has conquered death, and through Him, we are more than conquerors.

## **Application**

Today, identify areas in your life where you need to declare God's victory. Whether facing personal challenges, relational conflicts, or spiritual warfare, stand firm in the knowledge that the battle belongs to the Lord. How does this assurance change your perspective on current difficulties?

Day 4: Deciding to Follow Christ Daily

Bible Reading: Luke 9:23-26

### Devotional

Devotional: Following Christ is a daily decision. Jesus calls us to deny ourselves, take up our cross daily, and follow Him. This decision impacts every aspect of our lives.

# **Application**

Today, consciously choose to follow Christ in your actions, words, and thoughts. What does it look like to "deny yourself" in your current circumstances? How can you demonstrate that you're not ashamed of Christ and His words in your daily interactions?



**Day 5: Reflecting God's Character** 

Bible Reading: 1 Peter 1:13-16

### **Devotional**

As Christians, we bear Christ's name and are called to reflect His character. Peter reminds us of God's call to be holy in all we do. This pursuit of holiness isn't about perfection but about allowing God's character to shine through us.

## **Application**

Today, examine your life and identify areas where you can better reflect God's holiness. How can you demonstrate God's love, justice, mercy, and grace to those around you? Remember, pursuing holiness is not about following rules, but about growing in relationship with a holy God and allowing His nature to transform you.
