

Day 1: The Promise of God's Purpose

**Bible Reading: Romans 8:28** 

## **Devotional**

Life can sometimes feel like a storm, raging out of control and leaving us to wonder where God is in the midst of our trials. Today, let's focus on the promise found in Romans 8:28, where we are assured that God is working all things together for our good. Reflect on the challenges you face and consider how they might be shaping you for a greater purpose. Trust that God is weaving a tapestry of victory, even when the threads seem tangled from our earthly perspective.

## **Question for Reflection**

Can you identify a past struggle where you later saw God's purpose at work? How does this give you hope for your current challenges?

## Day 2: God's Unquestionable Authority and Our Honest Questions

**Bible Reading: Philippians 1:6** 

### **Devotional**

As we grow in our faith, it's natural to have questions and to wonder about the journey God has us on. Philippians 1:6 reassures us that the work God has started within us will be brought to completion. Today, let's bring our questions to God with the honesty of a child, trusting that He is still shaping us. God invites our curiosity and our desire for understanding, knowing that this can lead to deeper trust in Him.

# **Question for Reflection**

What questions have you been hesitant to bring before God, and how can you approach Him with childlike faith today?



Day 3: The Prophet's Struggle with God's Will

Bible Reading: Habakkuk 1:12-13; 2:3

### Devotional

The prophet Habakkuk wrestled with understanding God's will, especially when it didn't align with his own desires. As we read his honest conversation with God, we're reminded that it's okay to bring our struggles and doubts to the Lord. God reassures Habakkuk that His plans will unfold in His perfect timing. Today, let's meditate on the faithfulness of God and His timing, knowing that He is working behind the scenes for our ultimate good.

# **Question for Reflection**

How can you trust in God's timing today, even when His plans seem unclear or delayed?

## Day 4: Finding Hope in the Midst of Uncertainty

Bible Reading: Psalm 77

## **Devotional**

Like Habakkuk, the psalmist in Psalm 77 recalls God's past deeds to find hope amidst despair. When clouds of uncertainty roll in, we too can remember God's faithfulness. Today, let's recount the ways God has been our rock in previous trials and allow those memories to anchor us in the present. Even when all is not well, we can rest in the assurance that God is still good and His love for us is unchanging.

### **Ouestion for Reflection**

What memories of God's faithfulness can you call upon today to strengthen your hope in His promises?



**Day 5: Trusting God Through Our Doubts** 

Bible Reading: Mark 9:22-24

### **Devotional**

In Mark 9, a father expresses belief in Jesus' power to heal his son, while also admitting his struggle with unbelief. This honest confession leads to a miraculous healing. As we conclude our reading plan, let's echo this father's prayer: "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief." Let's trust that God accepts us, doubts and all, and that He is ready to help us grow in faith.

# **Questions for Reflection**

How can admitting your doubts to God lead to a deeper trust and reliance on Him? as you endure challenges for Christ's sake?
