

Day 1: God's Redeeming Love

Bible Reading: Psalm 98:1-3

Devotional

God's redeeming love is a powerful force that transforms lives. Just as the psalmist calls us to "sing a new song to the Lord," we too can celebrate the wonderful deeds God has done in our lives.

Application

Bible Reading: Psalm 98:9

Devotional

The psalm concludes with a reminder that the Lord is coming to judge the earth with righteousness and fairness. While this may sound daunting, for those who trust in God, it's a promise of ultimate justice and the setting right of all wrongs.

Application

How does this future hope impact how you live today? Let the assurance of God's just rule motivate you to live with integrity and to seek justice in your sphere of influence.



Day 5: Embracing God's Gift of Redemption

Bible Reading: Ephesians 2:8-10

Devotional

Salvation is a free gift from God, but receiving it fully often requires us to let go of things that compete for God's place in our lives. Reflect on areas where you might be holding back from fully embracing God's redemption. Are there habits, attitudes, or relationships that need to be surrendered? Remember, God's grace is sufficient, and His power is made perfect in our weakness.

Application

Today, take a step towards fully receiving God's gift by identifying one area to surrender to Him, trusting that His plans for you are good.
